1st Torchbearer MARIA BELLI

Maria Belli is a cross-country and biathlon skier. She was born and raised in Florina. She is 17 years old, a high school student.

From a very young age she came into contact with sports and at the age of 10 she started cross-country skiing combined with running. Since then, with systematic work and dedication, many successes have come, the most important of which are:

- 2 times silver balkan championships winner in biathlon 2022
- Champion of Greece 2023 in the women's category
- medals in Balkan championships in the junior categories
- Medals in all National cross-country skiing championships
- Participation in the world youth biathlon championship in Kazakhstan, in 2 European youth biathlon championships, in the European Youth Olympic Festival in

Italy Friuli Venezia Giulia 2023, as well as in other international biathlon events.

Alpine Skiathlete, Apostolos is 17 years old. He is a high school student at Anatolia College. In 2022 he attended the International Ski Academy Apex2100 in France.

Last Torchbearer SHIN-EE YUN

Skiing athlete. Shin-ee Yun is 16 years old. High school student. She has taken part in many world championships in the mogul competition. In 2022, she won 1st place in 3 Korean National Sport competitions: 103rd Korea Winter Sports Festival, 76th Korea National championship, 74th Korea Ski Association President cup.

I am Yoon Shin, a member of the Korean national freestyle mogulski team.

When I was about 5 years old, I went to ski resort for first time with my parents and started learning skiing in earnest. The charm of skiing captivated me, and from that point on, I spent every winter vacation at the ski resort. When I was in the third grade, I moved to Pyeongchang and since then I essentially lived in the ski resort. The 2018 Pyeongchang Olympic Winter Games, the first winter Olympic Games held in Korea, was an opportunity for me to become a Mogul ski athlete in winter sports.

The Games took place at the ski resort in front of my house, where I used to visit every day. I witnessed performances of famous athletes up close and that fueled my aspiration to represent my country on the national team one day. I nurtured my dream while watching the Pyeongchang 2018 Olympic Winter Games and I am currently a member of the Mogul ski national team and about to participate in the Gangwon 2024 Winter Youth Olympic Games. When I first became a member of the national team, I was really happy. However, I am aware that I have a long road ahead and I think this is the beginning.

I want to make good memories and experiences by interacting with young people around the world at Gangwon

2024, the world's best sports competition for young athletes, and participate as a Mogul ski athlete representing Korea in the Milano Cortina 2026 Olympic Winter Games.
